

ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES - TITLE 16 - ELECTIONS AND ELECTORS

ARTICLE 16-544 Active early voting list; civil penalty; violation; classification; definition

- H. 1. THE VOTER REQUESTS IN WRITING TO BE REMOVED FROM THE ACTIVE EARLY VOTING LIST.
- I. A VOTER MAY MAKE A WRITTEN REQUEST AT ANY TIME TO BE REMOVED FROM THE ACTICE EARLY VOTING LIST. THE REQUEST SHALL INCLUDE THE VOTER'S NAME, RESIDENCE ADDRESS, DATE OF BIRTH AND SIGNATURE. ON RECEIPT OF A COMPLETED REQUEST TO REMOVE A VOTER FROM THE ACTIVE EARLY VOTING LIST, THE COUNTY RECORDER OR OTHER OFFICER IN CHARGE OF ELECTIONS SHALL REMOVE THE VOTER'S NAME FROM THE LIST AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE.
